An **Associate of Science (A.S.) in Industrial Technology** degree is being offered by Black Hills State University at **RTEC** (Regional Technical Education Center) **in Yankton.**

BHSU will be offering an A.S. in Industrial Technology in Yankton through RTEC. This program is a 64-credit hour degree program, which consists of technical courses, general education courses and electives. Mount Marty College is partnering with BHSU to offer courses to meet the general requirements for this program.

Mount Marty College offers a variety of programs for students to complete a bachelor's degree after completion of this A.S. in Industrial Technology degree. Courses through this program will transfer to Mount Marty for credit towards a bachelor's degree.
