



Mount Marty earns 6th win of season over NAIA Top 25 Opponent

Kylie Gross' two free throws with 12 seconds left proved to be the game winners as Mount Marty defeated #13 ranked Morningside College 74-73 to sweep the season series versus the defending NAIA National Champions. Mount Marty had four players in double figures led by Jenny Miller's 22 points. Also in double figures were Gross and Michelle Amundson with 14, and Kendra Schomer with 11 points. In the teams' first meeting on December 12th in Sioux City, IA, a layup by Michelle Amundson with 5 seconds left gave the Lancers a 75-73 road victory over then #18 ranked Morningside.

Wednesday's victory marked the sixth time this season that the Mount Marty Lancers have beaten a team that was rated in the top 25 in the NAIA Poll. In addition to their two wins over Morningside College, the Lancers have victories against #8 Bethel, IN (82-58) on Oct. 30, #9 Black Hills State (61-58) on Nov. 6, #6 Jamestown, ND (69-59) on Nov.14, and #22 Concordia, NE (81-68) on Nov. 21. The Lancers will have another match-up with a top 25 opponent in their next game when they travel to Orange City, IA on Wednesday, Feb. 3rd to face #5 Northwestern College.
